In 2013, we continued making strides with Strong4Life, our program to lead the fight against childhood obesity in Georgia.

- Strong4Life served more than 300,000 kids. The program has impacted more than 500,000 kids since inception.
- Strong4Life trained 1,082 healthcare providers. More than 2,500 healthcare providers have been trained in 95 counties since beginning in 2011.
- Strong4Life worked with more than 400 schools, educating school nurses,
 PE teachers, school cafeteria managers and students.
- The Health4Life Clinic saw more than 1,200 patient visits and helped achieve 87 percent stabilization or reduction of patients' BMI
- Camp Strong4Life hosted more than 100 campers and family members and helped 80 percent of campers decrease body fat and reduce/maintain BMI.
