

Michael Mina, MD, PhD is an Epidemiologist, Immunologist and Clinical Pathologist, and is Chief Science Officer at eMed. Prior to eMed, Dr. Mina was a professor in the Center for Communicable Disease Dynamics at the Harvard School of Public Health and associate medical director for molecular virology at Brigham and Women's Hospital, Harvard Medical School, and at the Broad Institute of MIT and Harvard.

Dr. Mina has been at the forefront of the COVID pandemic, both in the development of new approaches to testing for public health and immunity-based surveillance and serving as an advisor at all levels of federal, state and international governments. At eMed he is currently leading two large NIH funded programs, including the NIH Home Test to Treat Program and the Paxlovid Rebound Cohort Study.
