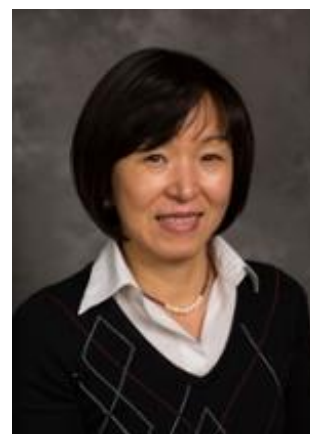
This pilot explored whether children with NAFLD have elevated arsenic levels in both urine and nail samples compared to age- and gender-matched, healthy children without NAFLD.
