Emory + Pediatrics/Winship - Data Policy (Backup/Storage and Recovery)

- 1. All users must backup their data off the instrument at the end of their run. This can be done during the cleaning phase.
- 2. OneDrive is the preferred method; all users are given 5TB of free storage with their Emory Account (25TB using the labs Teams account).
- 3. Data (including experiments) stored on the instruments will be deleted on a monthly basis; i.e. for January's data this will be deleted in March.
- All users are required to name their experiments according to their lab policies.
 (Experiment_001 or variations of are not valid experiment names and makes it harder for us to search for them).
- 5. Data is backed up nightly to the Flow Core NAS.
- 6. Data will be retained for one year on the NAS and then deleted; this will happen on a rolling monthly basis.
- 7. For a fee, users may request recovery of files which will be delivered within 72hrs of the request. Users will be required to fill out the Data Recovery Request form.
- 8. The flow core highly recommends saving your experiments as Templates.
